biographies

Angharad Davies is a freelance musician based in London. She is active on the European New Music and Improvisation scene with groups such as Broken Consort, Chris Burn's Ensemble, Buruk, Common Objects, and Cranc Trio. She has recently returned from a tour with experimental actress Kazuko Hoki and performed with Tony Conrad at the *Kill Your Timid Notion* film festival in February 2006. Her music to Sam Rebello's film *Residual Matter* was shown at the Whitechapel Gallery in March, and will have its second showing at the *Evolution* film festival in Leeds next month.

Stefan Thut regularly performs new experimental music, both as a soloist and in various ensembles. He is also a member of the Basle Sinfonietta. His repertoire includes the great solo works by John Cage (Etudes Boreales) and Xenakis (Nomos A.) Solo works have been commissioned from Antoine Beuger, Jürg Frey, Manfred Werder, Radu Malfatti, James Saunders. Forthcoming recordings on Edition Wandelweiser Records. He lives in Solothurn, Switzerland.

Tim Parkinson is an independent composer, based in London, a pianist and concert organiser, forming working relationships with musicians without intention of forming an ensemble. Studied with Kevin Volans. In 2001 attended the Ostrava New Music Days in the Czech Republic, attended seminars with Petr Kotik, Alvin Lucier, Zsolt Nagy and Christian Wolff. Music written for various ensembles including Apartment House, Reservoir, The London Sinfonietta, Chroma, and Duo Contour. Music also written for various soloists including Steve Altoft, Julia Eckhardt, Anton Lukoszevize, Andrew Sparling, Craig Shepard.
